Parish Council Meeting

- Notes from previous meeting read out.
- Highways Agency meeting held Friday 22nd June 9:30am with Sharon Fox (Highways customer communications officer for North Yorkshire). The following was discussed:
 - T Junction at West End Lane. Sight line of Cherry Tree on the left and Ash Tree on the right, now makes it a blind exit. Issue raised.
 - Thorntree lane hedges – some are highways, and some are the landowners.
 - Parish room pathway discussed. Highways to curb near path. Parish council to extend path to the side to provide another entry point.
 - South End sign looking to move to the opposite side of the road.
 - West End or West End lane – there is a discrepancy on the ordnance survey map.
 - Weight limit on road is 7.5 tons from A 19 all the way to South End of Long Lane Pollington. It is applicable to the village. Anything larger only acceptable if access needed to the village. It is not enforced. The lack of signage re weight was raised.
 - Road widening not possible as no budget. It would have to be done by Parish Council.
 - Other signs have been asked for.
 - Sharon to respond to meeting.
- All corners and verges to be done by council. Meeting with Weedfree, they have confirmed what they will do and will continue to do re verges.
- Litter pick needs to be left until beginning of April 2019.
- Weedfree meeting other points:
 - Table and chairs, Parish Council to choose and Weedfree to make a contribution.
 - Central heating is expected to be done at same time as Weedfree in August.
- Grass cutting £480+VAT to be paid to J Andrews. There is no plan to recut this year but will review in September.

- Coffee morning proposed:
 - 21st July Alzheimer's to be supported by Cllr N Andrews and Cllrs R Dunning.
 - 29th September Macmillan to be supported by Chairman Woodward and Clerk.
 - 1st December Help the Aged to be supported by Cllr T Birley and provisionally Cllr H Lewis.
- Possibility of bike shelter was raised to councilor. It was discussed and decided that the cost to individual benefit ratio was too high.
