

Meeting 165

Parish Council Meeting

Room on Monday 29th October 2018 at 7-30pm

Present: Chairman Cllr Woodward, Cllrs Andrews, Cllr Dunning, Cllr Lewis and Cllr Birley

Apologies: Cllr White

- Notes from previous meeting read out – one amended to be made re name should be S Parkin not C Parking.
- Central heating – electrician coming 30th October, time to be confirmed. They will assess the heating requirements of the Parish room. Current thinking is 3 required, 2 for the main room and one for the Kitchen.
- Insurance valuation covered is £90,982 which is believed to be sufficient. Concern raised at previous meeting that cover may not take into account work carried out on the room over the years.
- Cllr Birley has donated plug in air fresheners to make the room a more pleasant environment. Thanks, from the Parish Council. Proposer Cllr Andrews, Seconded Cllr Dunning.
- Craft event being held 1st December 2019 being run by Cllr Birley and Cllr Lewis.
- Christmas Celebration proposed for 15th December for 2:30pm until 5pm. Parish council to provide mince pies, mulled wine etc.
- Parish room tables were bowed. Replacements expected week commencing 5th November.
- West End Lane – electricity board cut tops of some of the trees on the Kealey side of the road.
- Proposed that Lime trees are to be taken out of West End Lane, enabling hedge owners to maintain their hedges. Any small trees will be moved to Jenny Lane, if possible. The plan would be to carry out the work once the trees have lost their leaves. This proposal was unanimously agreed.
- Highways – at the time of the meeting, no acknowledgement of the email had been received. Email to be resent.
- Some of the signs in the village are dirty. The cleaning of these signs will co-inside with the litter pick next year.

- Meeting minutes – Cllr Andrews requested paper copies for his records, all other councilors are happy to receive on email or via the website.
- Last meeting minutes agreed, with the proposed amendment. Proposer Cllr Andrews, Seconded Cllr Lewis.

New Business:

- Cllr Dunning received letter from Ethical Partnership re opportunities for Junction near Pollington Park, but nothing has been received by the Parish Council.
- Cherry Tree farm planning application, information to be chased by Clerk.
- Parish Clerk options to be consider for next year by Parish Councilors and discussed at the next meeting.
- Shooting – some landowners have given permission to shooting groups outside of the community. Unfortunately, no notification of when these shoots are occurring is provided to enable those in effected area to take precautions for livestock and pets. Letter to be written to one of the shooting groups asking them to notify before shoot, Proposer Cllr Lewis, Seconded Cllr Birley.
